

COOKIE POLICY OF POLEMA JSC

COLLECTING INFORMATION

To use the website <https://polema.net> / (hereinafter referred to as "the Site"), owned by Polema JSC, registration and authorization are not required. If an Internet user (hereinafter referred to as "the User") is a Website visitor, Polema JSC does not collect any personal information about him, except for data using cookies.

TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

Cookies are text files that store information about the User's actions on this resource after visiting the Site. Cookies are placed on the user's computer/smartphone or other device by the Website after the User has visited it. Cookies do not affect the operating system of the User's computer/smartphone or other device. Cookies are not used to identify the User of the Website.

PURPOSES OF COLLECTING INFORMATION THROUGH COOKIES

Polema JSC uses cookies to collect information about the User's hardware and software, IP addresses, date and time of the session and is processed in order to improve the operation of the Site, information about User actions on the Site is processed to analyze User behavior, as well as to identify User preferences for a certain type of content, as well as for the purposes of improving the robustness of the Site's security system. Processing by Polema JSC of information collected through Cookies will be terminated upon achievement of the specified purposes.

TYPES OF COOKIES USED

Cookies used by the Website can be roughly divided into the following types:

Required cookies

Without such cookies, the proper functioning of the Website is impossible. These files are responsible for storing User authorization data (email addresses). Among other things, they allow Polema JSC to identify hardware and software, including the User's browser type. The user can configure his browser so that it blocks these cookies or notifies about them, but in this case some components of the Site will stop working. These cookies do not store User identification data.

Functional cookies

These cookies help Polema JSC to calculate statistics on the number of Site visitors and investigate traffic sources so that Polema JSC can evaluate and improve the effectiveness and usability of the site for the user. These cookies allow to find out which pages are the most popular or are of least interest to Users, and how Users navigate the Site. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and, accordingly, anonymous. If the User prohibits the use of these cookies, Polema JSC will not be able to track User visits to the Site and will not be able to regulate its operation. These cookies allow to remember the settings selected by the user, which will be automatically activated on subsequent visits to the Site.

Cookies responsible for efficiency

Some cookies help Polema JSC evaluate the effectiveness of the Website, optimize its design and generally make it more convenient and modern. They also collect statistics on visits to various pages of the Site and analyze how users navigate to the page.

Cookies responsible for monitoring and personalization

This type of cookies allows Polema JSC to receive information about the interests and needs of Users. The use of such cookies helps to create the most relevant content. These cookies allow to determine which resource Users have accessed the site from, which browser they are using, as well as the nature of the data that was downloaded from the Site. This information is collected anonymously by third-party web service providers.

Social media cookies

This type of cookies is used to collect information about the use of social media.

RETENTION PERIOD OF COOKIES

Polema JSC uses information contained in the types of cookies described above.

Cookies will be stored on the User's device for the period necessary to achieve their purpose, after which they will be automatically deleted from the User's device.

The retention period on the user's device may vary for different types of cookies.



HOW TO OPT OUT OF COOKIES

After disabling cookies in the web browser, the User may find that some sections of the site do not work properly.

Instructions on how to manage cookies in a browser can usually be found in the browser's help desk. On the first visit to the Website, Polema JSC requests the User's consent to use cookies.

If after the User has approved the use of cookies, the User wants to change his decision, such a User can do so by deleting the cookies stored in his browser.

After that the Site can re-request the User's consent to use cookies, and the User will be able to make a different choice.
